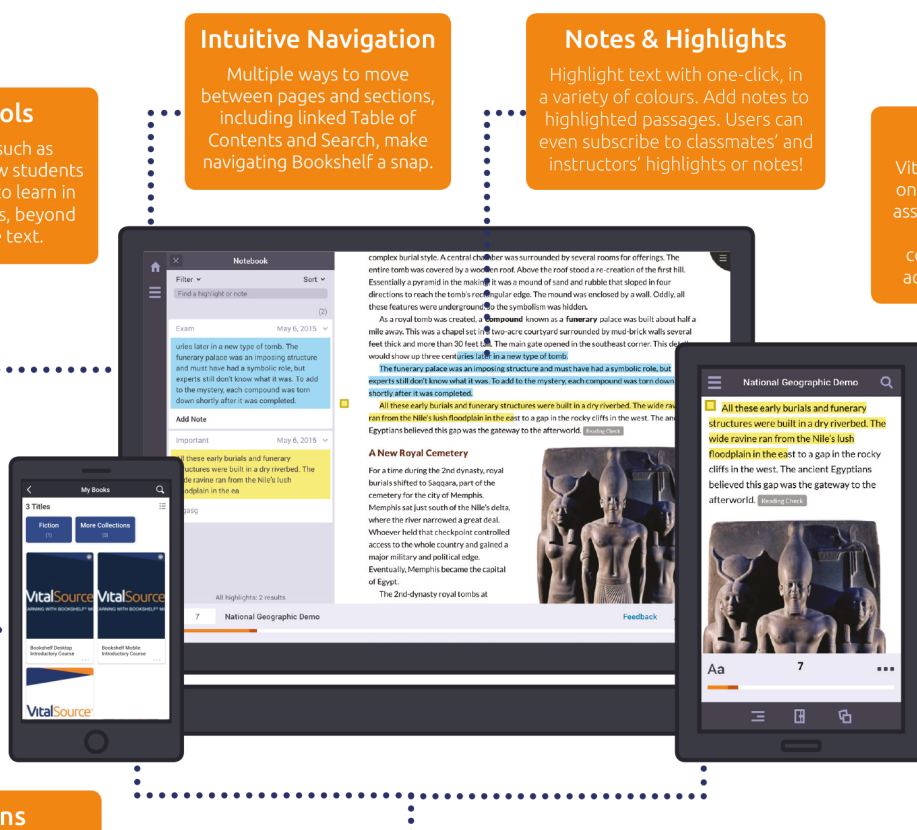

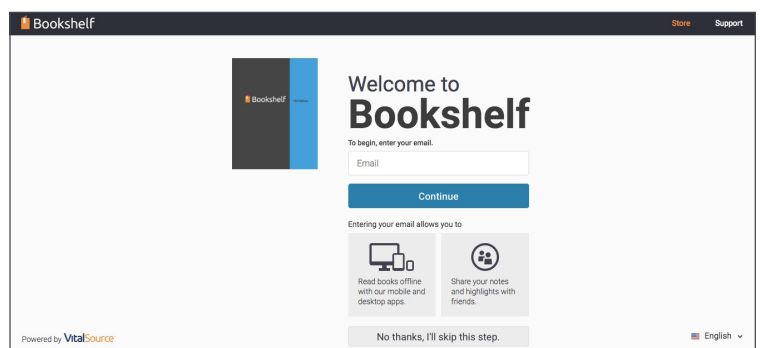

## Accessing Your eTextbook for the First Time from Blackboard

- Login to Blackboard with the credentials provided by your University
- Click on the assigned eTextbook title on your course, which will take you to the Bookshelf welcome screen:

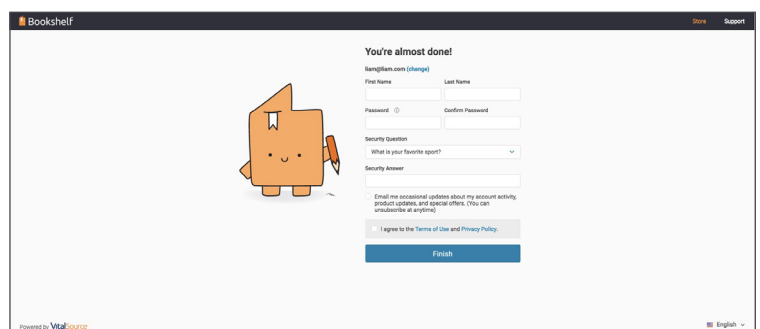
### Welcome to Bookshelf

- Enter your email address – this is your Bookshelf login ID.
- If you already have a Bookshelf account, enter your password and log in.
- If you are new to Bookshelf, you will be directed to the next step, where you will be asked to sign up for a Bookshelf account.



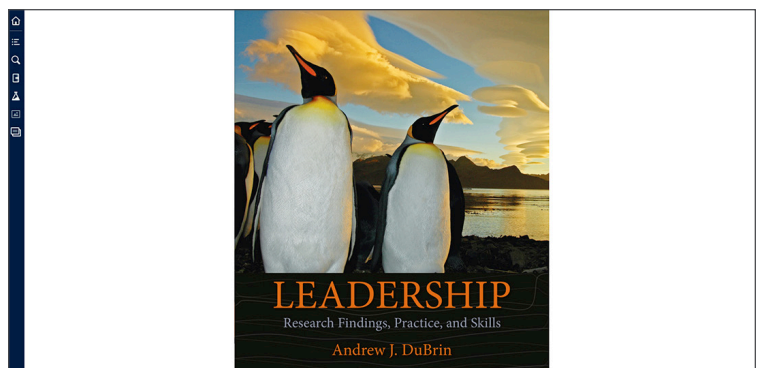
### Create an Account

- Enter your email address, your first and last name, choose a security answer/question, then create and confirm a password for your account.
- Tick to agree to the terms of use and privacy policy, then click on 'Finish'.



### eTextbook Launch

- Once you have created an account, the eTextbook will launch within your Bookshelf account.



## How to Download

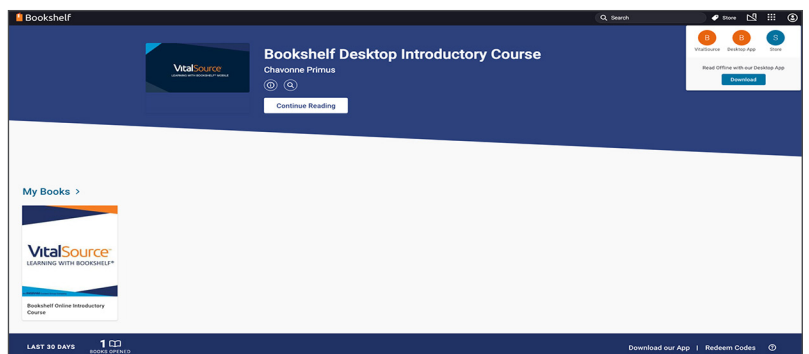
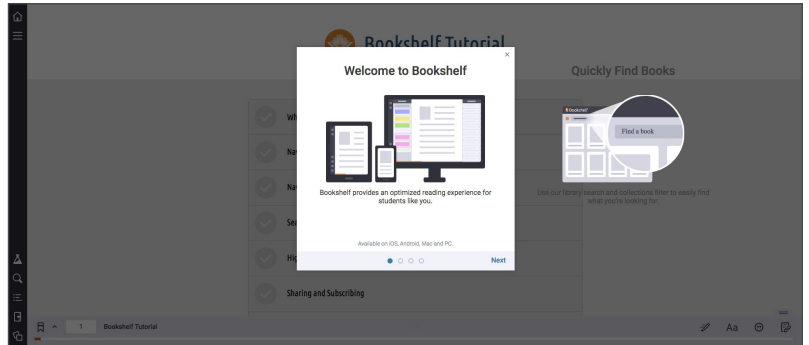
### Reading eTextbooks offline

- Click on the operating system (IOS, Android, Mac or PC) you are using and proceed to download the Bookshelf application.

### To download an app from within Bookshelf, there are 2 options:

#### 1. From your digital library

- Click the grid icon and then the 'Download App' option.
- Or click 'Download our App' in the right of the bottom bar.

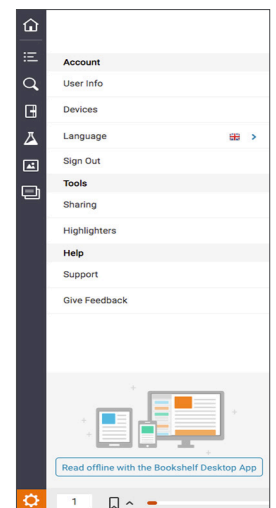
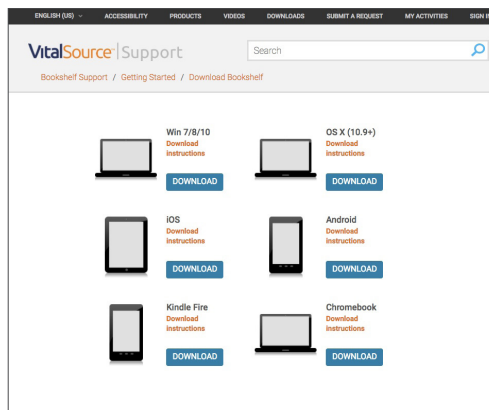


#### 2. From inside an eTextbook

- Click the settings icon and then the 'Read offline with the Bookshelf Desktop App' option.

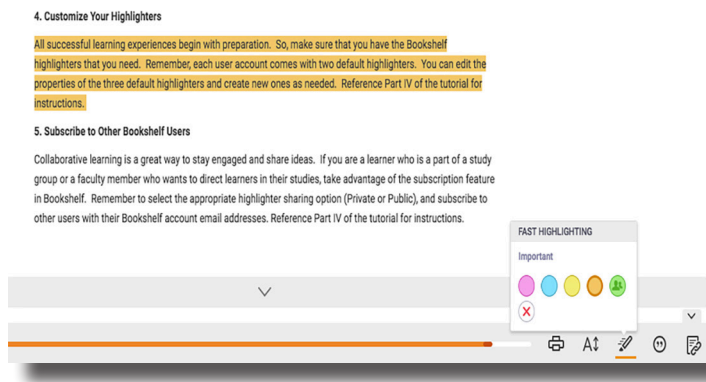
### Download an app from outside Bookshelf

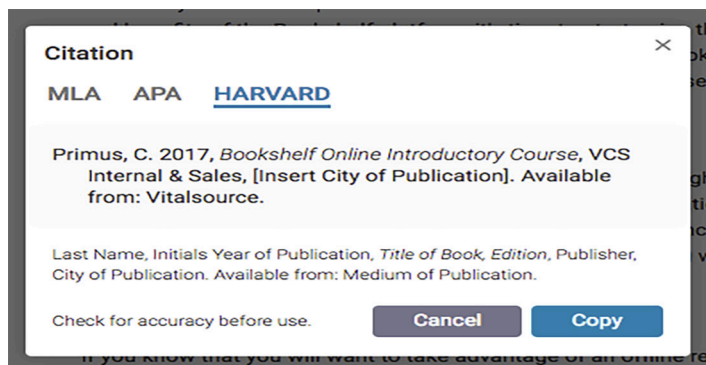
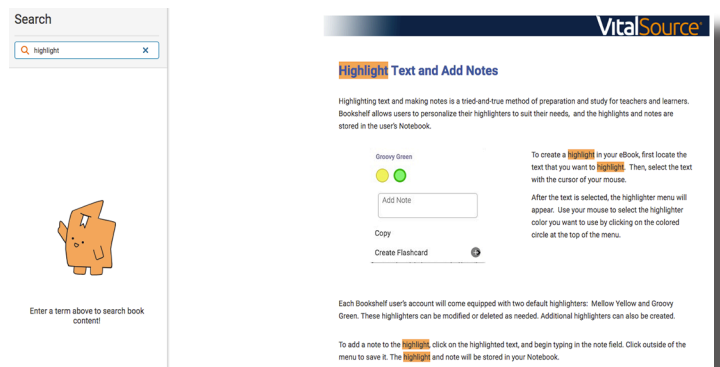


## Get Organised

Select sections of text to copy, bookmark, highlight or make notes so that you can return easily to key passages. Use colour coding to manage your highlights relating to different assignments. Keep notes and highlights private, share with friends, or share publicly.

## Speed up your Search

Search within your book for a keyword or for figures, and click straight through to that content. You can search for single words, phrases or exact phrases by adding quotation marks. You can even search highlights that you have made.

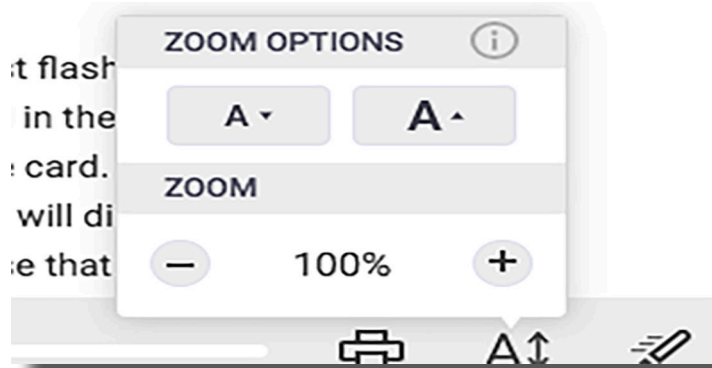


## Improve your Referencing

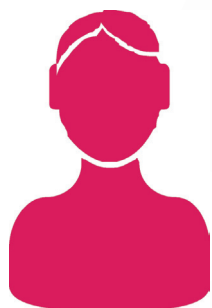
